Washington Profile of a Graduate and DESSA Items Crosswalk

The Washington State <u>Profile a Graduate</u>, published in 2021, is a guiding vision for the K-12 education system. Developed with local input, it identifies the skills, knowledge, attributes, and competencies necessary for a successful transition to life after high school.

The DESSA suite of assessments measures key social and emotional competencies essential for student success now and into the future. The DESSA assessments span K-12 and can be completed by educators, students, and parents or guardians. The assessments are nationally standardized, norm-referenced, strength-based behavior rating scales, measuring the positive skills, behaviors, and mindsets necessary for students to thrive.

This crosswalk highlights the alignment between the Washington Profile of a Graduate Skills and Abilities and the DESSA assessment items. This tool demonstrates how districts and schools can use DESSA assessments in conjunction with the Profile of a Graduate to ensure that Washington students develop not only the knowledge they need, but also the abilities to adapt, collaborate, and excel in a rapidly changing world.
